- Your organization will be provided with an 8ft or 16ft foot space, tables and chairs.
- For set-up, vehicles can be used from 7am-9am but must be parked in designated areas after this time
- The festival runs from 10am-1pm
- Power provided for an additional fee

Selection Criteria

We are excited to welcome twenty community booths to participate in the Food Run festival that will occur alongside the walk/run portion of the event. To celebrate healthy eating and living, the ideal community booth will provide interactive programming for participants (food samples, demonstrations, presentations, professional guidance, etc). The focus of your community booth should address at least one of our four event objectives:

- 1) To promote active living for all ages
- 2) To educate the community on healthy eating and lifestyles
- 3) To raise funds for Feed Nova Scotia
- 4) To create an event that gives back to the community
